Neil Numark is the President of NUMARK Associates, Inc., a Washington, DC-based energy and environmental consulting firm specializing in technical support, research, and management services to U.S. and international government and private sector clients. He founded the firm in 1991 after previous positions on the staff of the U.S. Congress, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the company International Energy Associates Limited. Mr. Numark has worked extensively on subjects including U.S. energy and climate policy; international nuclear fuel cycle and non-proliferation issues; disposition of surplus weapons plutonium; nuclear waste management policy; and deregulation of the U.S. electric power sector. He has been a member of the Civil Nuclear Trade Advisory Committee (CINTAC) to the U.S. Secretary of Commerce since January 2015.
